Dear Chairman Gordon:

I write on behalf of the undersigned higher education associations to commend you for introducing H.R. 362, the 10,000 Teachers, 10 Million Minds Science and Math Scholarship Act, and to pledge our support for its enactment.

The 10,000 Teachers, 10 Million Minds Science and Math Scholarship Act will advance STEM education in the United States by strengthening the Robert Noyce Scholarship program for the teachers it seeks to attract. Additionally, H.R. 362 would improve instruction for tomorrow's teachers through important enhancements to the Mathematics and Science Education Partnerships program. Finally, your legislation will promote 21<sup>st</sup> century math and science curriculum development by requiring the director of the National Science Foundation (NSF) to convene an expert panel aimed at evaluating existing math and science teaching materials, and by expanding the Science, Mathematics, Engineering and Technology Talent Expansion program to include new centers charged with developing and disseminating curriculum and best practices for the teaching profession.

By taking specific steps to attract, train, support and equip our nation's next generation of math and science teachers, the 10,000 Teachers, 10 Million Minds Science and Math Scholarship Act represents a comprehensive and credible response to the National Academy of Sciences' call to recruit and educate 10,000 math and science teachers annually. Thank you for your leadership and ongoing commitment to American education.
