

## 2013 ACE/AIEA Internationalization Collaborative Aligning International Strategy and Institutional Goals

The Internationalization Collaborative is a national forum for addressing the opportunities and challenges of campus internationalization. Over the course of its thirteen-year history, more than one hundred institutions have participated in its annual meetings. In 2012, as part of the development of a broader partnership between ACE and the Association of International Education Administrators, ACE and AIEA began to jointly sponsor the Collaborative in conjunction with the AIEA annual meeting. The Collaborative is open to any institution of higher education in the United States.

The theme for this year's Collaborative is "Aligning international strategy and institutional goals." The objective is to help institutions integrate their international goals into their overall institutional goals, with a particular focus on the working relationship between the campus leader for internationalization and other senior campus leaders, including the president and provost. We hope that participants will leave the meeting with a deeper understanding of how institutions develop their overall goals, and that this understanding will translate into internationalization strategies that are fully integrated into broader institutional strategies.

The format of the Collaborative annual meeting has several unique characteristics. In keeping with the theme for this year, we will begin with a plenary panel of college presidents who will share their experiences with strategic planning and internationalization on their campuses. The afternoon panel will explore the same issues from the perspective of the senior campus leader for internationalization. The Collaborative continues to put a strong emphasis on small group discussion, which allows institutions to share experiences and good practices. Beginning this year, participants will also have the opportunity to collaborative electronically before and after the meeting.
