- To promote a college-going culture
- To connect students, families, and high schools with colleges and universities earlier, giving families time to consider their options and plan for their student's future
- To ease the transition from high school to college
- To show students that they have access to a certificate, associate's or bachelor's degree program if they choose to further their education in Idaho

Direct Admissions: An Overview

A program to proactively admit high school seniors to Idaho institutions based on <u>unweighted</u> GPA and SAT/ACT score (at the end of their junior year) into two groups.

Group of 8

- Students with GPA equal to or greater than 3.0, or
- SAT math & reading multiplied by GPA equal to or greater than 2835
- An equivalent ACT score can be used

Students meeting this benchmark are notified of admission to <u>all eight</u> of Idaho's public colleges and universities:

- Boise State University
- University of Idaho
- Idaho State University
- Lewis-Clark State College

- College of Eastern Idaho
- College of Western Idaho
- North Idaho College
- College of Southern Idaho


Group of 6

- Students below the benchmark are notified of admission to <u>six</u> Idaho public higher education institutions:
 - Idaho State University College of Technology
 - Lewis-Clark State College
 - College of Eastern Idaho

- College of Western Idaho
- North Idaho College
- College of Southern Idaho
- Students are encouraged to review individual admissions requirements of institutions, as they may be eligible for admission under the regular admission guidelines.



More Students Applying

- ICAW Site Coordinators
 - "I think more students applied to more colleges than they would have before."
 - "Having every student do Apply Idaho at the same time helps to catch students who are reluctant to begin the application process. One student (who is on the border line of attending college/not)told me he is now getting calls from schools. He now feels validated and more encouraged to try and go on!!"
 - "It was simple and easy so even students who might not be sure about attending college filled out applications."




Total Number of Apps

 - Doesn't always filter up

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


