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INSTITUTIONAL OVERVIEWS



Ivy Tech Community College System

- 180,000 students
- 14 regions, 75 delivery sites around the state
- Transfer, technical, professional, lifelong learning educational mission
- 13.6% African American, more than half of all African America students enrolled in IN

- Average class size of 22
- \$131 per credit
- CPL strategies:
 - Crosswalks: military, AP/IB, and certification
 - Testing
 - Portfolios





Miami Dade College

- Over 165,000 students attend MDC
- Seven campuses, three centers, and several extension centers
- Over 300 programs of study certificates, associate, and bachelor degrees
- Ethnic mix: 71% are Hispanic or Latino, 18% African-American, 7% Caucasian, 4% other
- Serve 3500 veterans
- 62% of students attend part-time

- Nearly 40% of our students are 26 years of age or older
- 73% of students with an AA transfer to a Florida university to continue education
- CPL methods include:
 - Credit by Exam
 - Evaluation of Military Training
 - Evaluation of local noncollegiate training and workplace training programs
 - Portfolio-based Assessment





SUNY Empire State

Leadership and Advocacy

- Largest Liberal Arts College within the SUNY System
- Offers Associate Bachelor's and Master's degrees
- 35 locations across NY state, online and international
- About 20,000 students: 90% undergraduate
- 10% are military/veteran students
- All undergraduate students design their own degree using competency based guidelines
- Credit for Prior Learning has been a critical part of the degree planning process since college opened in 1971
- Types of CPL Include:
 - Standardized Examinations
 - All ACE Military & Corporate Credits
 - All NCCRS credits
 - Professional Learning Evaluations
 - Individualized Portfolio Assessment
