Dear Speaker McCarthy and Democratic Leader Jeffries:

On behalf of the undersigned organizations, we write to express our strong opposition to H.R. 5525, the Continuing Appropriations and Border Security Enhancement Act for fiscal year (FY) 2024. This continuing resolution (CR) includes an 8.13% reduction in spending across all agencies except Defense and Veterans Affairs.

A CR is preferable to the disruption caused by a government shutdown, but a CR should be exactly what it is intended to be, the continuation of funding at current levels. If enacted, H.R. 5525 will only cause confusion and drastically reduce funding to students and institutions of higher education. Operating under a CR also creates a level of uncertainty for institutions of higher education when it comes to things such as packaging financial aid awards and operating federally funded programs.

We urgently call on Congress to work together to enact appropriations measures that, at the very least, keep the government funded at the agreed upon levels in the Fiscal Responsibility Act. Should a CR be the best path forward in the interim, we strongly recommend that the funding levels remain the same as FY 2023.
