



Top 5 U.S. Cities for Advanced Manufacturing

For at least 20 years, many Americans all but wrote off manufacturing as of factory jobs simply evaporated or went overseas. It's time to think again. Advanced manufacturing has come roaring back to life in many places, often in the nation's hardest-hit industrial towns. Many advanced manufacturing jobs don't require a four-year college degree, so you can start working and earning just a year or two after high school. But make no mistake: this is not low-skilled work. Most of the fastest-growing jobs in the sector -- like computercontrolled machine operation or repair of high-tech industrial equipmentrequire strong math, science, and technology skills.

These middle-skilled advanced manufacturing jobs* are likely to become even hotter as older workers retire. Fifty-two percent of the advanced manufacturing workforce is 45 or older. Compare that to just 42 percent for the workforce as a

#FixFAFSA: Share Your Stories

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) enables millions of students to attend college. However, the complexity and length of the application results in low completion rates. Only 44 percent of high school seniors complete the form by graduation and college students leave roughly \$24 billion in federal student aid unclaimed.

Every year, NCAN hears stories from our members about the struggles students have with the FAFSA form. Bryce is a student at James Madison University. Served by the ACCESS College Foundation in both high school and college, Bryce completed his own FAFSA during his freshman year of college to return sophomore year. After making an error on the form, Bryce lost his full scholarship to JMU. With the help of his ACCESS advisor, Bryce was able to correct his FAFSA, regain his scholarship, and remain enrolled in college.




